Health Screening

Pre-screening Guidelines

How do I prepare for a health screening?

- To prepare for the health screening, you will need to fast for 10 hours the night before your scheduled appointment. However, if need be, only sips of water may be taken during the fasting.
- After the blood test and abdominal ultrasound (for Premier Scan), a light breakfast will be served.

What are the dietary instructions before the screening?

In order to obtain a reliable result, you are advised to:

- Eat a diet rich in roughage, such as vegetables, salad, nuts, and wholemeal bread for three days before the start of the test.
- Avoid raw and half-cooked meat and cold cuts eg. steak tartar, steak, liver, salami during the period.
- Do not take any drug or vitamin preparation on the day of the screening.

What do I need to bring along for my appointment?

- Please bring along your NRIC/FIN or Passport for registration.
- For those with pre-existing medical conditions, please bring along any relevant medical reports, blood test results and/or medications.
- If your health screening plan includes a vision test, please do not put on your contact lenses on the day of your appointment. Remember to bring along your glasses that you normally use for distant and near vision.
- Please bring along a pair of track shoes, shorts and T-shirt for your treadmill stress test.

What do I expect during the health screening?

- After the blood test and abdominal ultrasound (for Premier Scan), a light breakfast will be served.
- Depending on your health screening plan, urine/stool samples may be taken for analysis. Containers will be provided to you on your arrival at the Health Screening Centre. Urine should be taken from the mid stream of your urine flow in order to obtain the most accurate results.
- You will then go through the series of tests in your health screening plan such as electrocardiogram, chest X-ray, ultrasound etc.
- At the end of your screening, we will arrange for an appointment for you to attend a medical review with our resident physician.
